ACQUISITION INFORMATION: The Maloney images were donated to the Tread of Pioneers Museum by Stella Garcia (associated with Mary Cox) in 2014. A Deed of Gift was signed in 2014.

PROCESSING INFORMATION: The processing, arrangement, and description of the Maloney collection was completed by intern Emily Eldridge in 2018.

BIOGRAPHY:

Anne Stehley Maloney was born in Champaign, Illinois, and first came to Steamboat Springs in July of 1920. She met and married Joseph C. Maloney the same year and they lived in Denver, with frequent visits to Steamboat Springs. In 1936 Anne Maloney moved to Steamboat Springs and took over management of the Acacia Hotel. She took many photos during her time in Steamboat Springs. Later in life she returned to Denver. Staff at Tread of Pioneers Museum believe the images were taken by Maloney, however the donor of the images Stella Garcia associates the collection with Mary Cox. No information has been found on Cox, according to Garcia, the Cox family was one of the first black families in the area.

SCOPE AND CONTENTS OF COLLECTION:

Several hundred personal photographs of Steamboat Springs and surrounding areas. Some are scenic, while many feature people. Notable people in photos include Dorothy Wither and Gloria Gossard and family; notable places include downtown Steamboat Springs, Rabbit Ears, and the Flat Tops.

ORGANIZATION OF THE COLLECTION: Order in which the collection was received was maintained. Images were kept with the original photograph processing envelopes.
